VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE AGREEMENT

It is hereby agreed by Daysha Monai Addison and the Division of Consumer Affairs (“Division”) of the Department of Commerce and Insurance, as follows:

WHEREAS, Chlora Lindley-Myers, is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Commerce and Insurance, State of Missouri (hereinafter, “Director” of the “Department”), whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374, 375 and 385, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance;

WHEREAS, the Division is charged with investigating producers and companies engaged in the business of Motor Vehicle Extended Service Contracts (“MVESC”) pursuant to Sections 374.085, 374.190 and 385.216, RSMo and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to MVESC;

WHEREAS, Daysha Monai Addison (“Addison”) has applied for a MVESC producer license with the Department, pursuant to Chapter 385, RSMo;

WHEREAS, the Division has received information concerning Addison’s misstatement on her application, which is a violation of Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo, and failure to timely report felony proceedings, which is a violation of Section 385.209.7 RSMo, and such conduct subjects Addison to enforcement action by the Director;

WHEREAS, Addison has been informed of her right to counsel and of her right to contest any attempt by the Department to refuse to issue her MVESC producer license, and states that she understands her rights to contest any such actions;


AND WHEREAS, Addison acknowledges and admits for purposes of this Agreement and for purposes of any future action by the Director or the Division based on an additional violation of the insurance laws, MVESC laws or regulations by Addison, in which action the Director or the Division alleges that the violations described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or that future violations by Addison are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law, by the misstatement on her application in violation of Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo, and by failing to timely report felony proceedings, in violation of Section 385.209.7 RSMo;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of any recommendation or initiation by the Division of any action based on the violation cited in this Agreement, and after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, Addison does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), such sum to be paid into the State School Moneys Fund pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.


Addison shall submit this sum to the Department by cashier's check or money order made payable to the State School Moneys Fund no later than January 26, 2023.

The parties agree that, should the Director or the Division in the future allege an additional violation of the insurance laws or regulations by Addison, nothing in this Agreement shall preclude the Director or the Division from introducing Addison's admissions contained in this Agreement as evidence that the acts described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or for purposes of showing that such later alleged acts are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law.


